Summary: 2021 Dump/Plow Truck Bids –

International - \$195,966.00

Freightliner - \$199,349.00

Mack - \$246,519.00

Kenworth & Peterbilt – Does not offer a mid-duty truck with front frame extensions from factory required for a plow. As such the opted not to bid.

The budgeted amount for this expense is approximately \$223,000.

Financial Impact: \$196,000.00

Recommendation: Except bid provided by International

Build Time: Approximately 150 day lead time on all supplies required for the build. Estimated time of completion would be late summer or fall of 2021. Hopefully the truck would be completed just in time to put into service for the 2021-22 winter season.

Trade-in Value: Estimated trade-in value of our 2005 International 4X2 plow truck is \$17-18,000

Retail Value: Finding a similarly equipped/comparable model truck for sale on the internet and other resources was difficult. I was able to find a couple somewhat comparable trucks in the \$25-35,000 price range. Selling the truck could be difficult as a 4X2 or two-wheel drive model is less desirable for plowing applications.
