You can now schedule Granby Connect rides up to 24 hours in advance - perfect for appointments, groceries, or shopping - and it's just \$2 per ride for your whole group! **Granby Connect runs daily from 9am to 9pm**, making getting around Granby easy and affordable! NUCHE VILLAGE

The Town of Granby continues to accept applications for Nuche Village, homes built for our community by our town. We are excited to welcome our first residents in November! Opportunities to purchase a home or rent an apartment are still available. To qualify, a person in your household must work an average of 32 hours per week for a Grand County Employer OR have worked in Grand County for at least 5 years prior to retirement. The home must be your primary residence. For rentals, total household income must be within 80- 120% of Area Media Income (AMI) based on household size. For home purchases: total household income must be below 160% AMI based on household size and total household assets must be less than 2x the sales price of the home being applied for. Those who work for Grand Fire or are employees within Granby are given first access and those who are Grand County graduates, are veterans and first responders, or work for a non-profit or special district are given extra entries.
