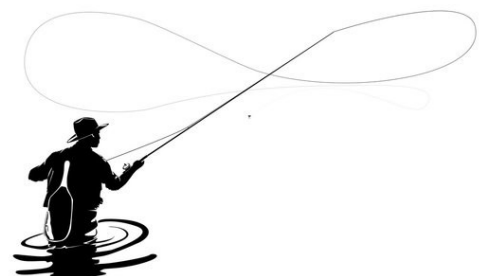

Fishing Reservations

Fishing at Granby Trails

Fish a stretch of the Colorado River on privately owned land near Granby Trails/Sun Outdoors Rocky Mtns. The one-mile Town owned stretch is divided into sections to prevent crowding and to create a more enjoyable outdoor experience. Fishing is offered on a pre-paid reservation only basis from late April through early November (conditions permitting). Fees are \$25 (for a 6-hour fishing block) for those with Granby (80446) addresses, and \$50 for all others. Reserve your beat at granbyrec.activityreg.com
