Summer Day Camp Registration

Walk-In registration for residents of the Town of Granby will be held on Tuesday, April 21 from 8:00AM until 5:30PM at the Granby Town Hall. Families must enroll their children in-person and bring proof of Town of Granby residency.

Walk-In Registration for all others will be a lottery system that will be held on Wednesday, April 22 from 8:00AM until 5:30PM at the Granby Town Hall. All families will be entered into the lottery and registration order will be drawn at 5:35PM on April 22. All families will be notified ASAP on April 23 with their schedule.

All Day Camp registrations will require a 4-week non-refundable deposit by May 1 or their spot will be forfeited to the next child on the waitlist.

Beginning Monday, April 27, we will take registrations over the phone and online as space is available. We anticipate that Day Camp will be filled before online registration begins, so please register ASAP!



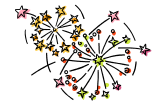
