TOWN CLERK

The 2024 General Election is on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. The Granby Town Hall will be open on Election Day for in-person voting from 7:00 AM - 7:00 PM. There is a 24-hour County controlled ballot drop box located outside the building available from October 18 at 8:00 AM through November 5 at 7:00PM.

Included in the Municipal section of the election will be three Trustee positions and the Mayor position. Each seat is a four year term. Board of Trustees (BOT) meetings are the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month. The agenda/packet deadline is the Monday one week prior to the meeting. FINANCE DEPARTMENT

The first draft of the 2025 Proposed Budget will be available for viewing online at townofgranby.com and at Town Hall beginning Oct. 15, 2024. A budget workshop will be held on Oct. 22nd prior to the BOT meeting. The public hearing and adoption of the budget will be on the Tuesday, Nov. 12 Board meeting.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Destination Granby will be participating in a six month long Colorado Challenge Accelerator Program hosted by Downtown Colorado Inc. This program will provide several downtown champions such as business owners and stakeholders with technical training to develop a catalyst site, such as a building or open space, to be reconfigured for community use. They are also participating in the Rural Business Development Grant for Tiny Towns which will provide small business support training to rural communities. NSA Water Treatment Plant Public Hearing

This meeting aims to inform the public about the project's scope, funding exploration, environmental impact, and benefits, as well as to gather community feedback and address any concerns.

PUBLIC WORKS

New emergency snow route regulations will go into effect this winter. This will prevent public parking on primary side streets during an Emergency Snowfall Event to allow better plow and emergency vehicle access. Notification of said events will be posted on the Town's website and Facebook account.



As a reminder, sidewalks should be cleared from snow within 24 hours of accumulation. Snow cannot be thrown into the street or onto another's property without permission. Please keep the streets clear of any obstructions such as garbage bins, vehicles, or trailers so the plows can safely clear the streets.

The Town's water systems will begin fall flushing at select locations throughout each distribution system to improve water quality and reduce turbid water events. During these flushes, timing and protocols will be in place to minimize disruptions of services to businesses and residents. If you encounter brown water during a flush, this is due to sediment moving through the line. Simply run your water for several minutes until it runs clear.
