A friendly reminder: if you come across young wildlife, please do not feed, approach, or disturb them—and avoid picking them up or posing for photos. Young animals are often left alone for extended periods, but this is normal and does not mean they've been abandoned. If the animal appears healthy, its mother is likely nearby and caring for it, so it's best to leave it undisturbed.

If you are concerned that an animal may be sick, injured, or truly abandoned, please contact Colorado Parks and Wildlife for guidance.

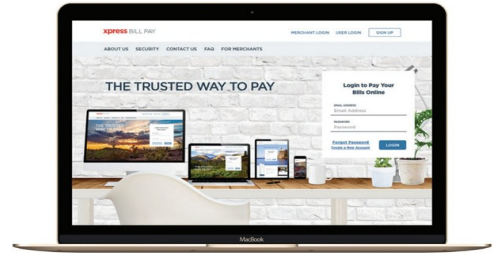
