A RESOLUTION PROTECTING THE SECURITY AND QUALITY OF LIFE OF THE CITIZENS OF ANYTOWN, BY DECLARATION OF A LAW AND ORDER CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Anytown is not, and will not, become a "Sanctuary City;" and

WHEREAS, Anytown's residents deserve to live free of increased taxes, increased crime, and decreased quality of life despite failed border policies.

WHEREAS, the safety and quality of life in Anytown is beloved by our law-abiding citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Anytown has observed the severe negative impacts on other American cities by their self-designation as "sanctuary cities" and the subsequent arrival of thousands of immigrants; and

WHEREAS. The City Council of Anytown will not degrade into the conditions of Denver, Colorado, where families cannot live safely or freely due to thousands of illegals wreaking havoc on the city and its residents.

WHEREAS, we will not work with any state, county, or local entity to facilitate the arrival of migrants into Anytown.

WHEREAS, the Federal Government continues to fail to secure our southern border, resulting in millions of immigrants entering our country and putting catastrophic stress on services such as hospitals, schools, and housing in "sanctuary cities."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANYTOWN: The City Council affirms remaining a Non-Sanctuary City and asserts it will not spend taxpayer dollars on services related to this crisis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; We are a Law & Order City and will do everything in our power to remove illegals from our community and send them to cities that have declared themselves as "sanctuary cities."

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; We call on the Federal Government to perform its constitutional duty and secure our nation's borders. We express our appreciation and solidarity with the State and Local Governments who are dealing with the chaotic and damaging surge of illegals entering our nation.
